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## DECIDUOUS SHRUBS

LIKE MOIST, NOT SOGGY SOIL. FERTILIZE MONTHLY, TRIM AS NEEDED

FLOWERING SHRUBS, TRIM BACK AFTER FLOWERING IN THE SPRING, THEN AGAIN IN THE FALL

## GROUND COVER

FERTILIZE BI-WEEKLY WITH MIRACID TRIM AS NEEDED

## GRASSES

FERTILIZE WITH A SLOW-RELEASE FERTILIZER, SUCH AS OSMOCOTE, CUT 4"-6" FROM GROUND IN MARCH

## PERENNIALS

FERTILIZE BI-WEEKLY WITH MIRACLE-GRO

CUT BACK IN THE FALL OR SPRING TO THE GROUND

## JUNIPERS

FERTILIZE MONTHLY WITH MIRACID, TRIM AS NEEDED

## PINE AND SHADE TREES

FERTILIZE WITH SPIKES, USE AS DIRECTED

## AZALEAS AND RHODODENDRONS

USE FERTILIZER SPECIFICALLY DESIGNED FOR THEM

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## WATERING

PLANTS SHOULD BE WATERED ONCE A WEEK DURING THE GROWING SEASON, IF RAINFALL IS LESS THAN 1" A WEEK

## PEST CONTROL

JUNIPERS AND SPRUCE ARE SUBJECT TO MITES AND BAGWORMS. WE RECOMMEND CYGON FOR A CONTROL. OTHER LEAF CHEWING INSECTS CAN BE CONTROLLED WITH DIAZINON. USE CHEMICALS ACCORDING TO PACKAGE DIRECTIONS

## WINTER CARE

ON BROADLEAF EVERGREENS, SUCH AS AZALEAS, BOXWOOD, HOLLIES, AND RHODODENDRONS, WE RECOMMEND WILT PRUF IN NOVEMBER. YOU MAY NEED SUBSEQUENT APPLICATIONS. IF EXTREME WEATHER CONDITIONS (BELOW 5 DEGREES) YOU MAY NEED TO COVER THESE

## FERTILIZATION

FERTILIZE AFTER THE FIRST YEAR FOLLOWING PLANTING. USE FERTILIZER DESIGNED FOR THE PARTICULAR PLANT BEING FERTILIZED AND FOLLOW DIRECTIONS.

## NEW SOD

NEW SOD NEEDS TO STAY MOIST/WET UNTIL IT ROOTS. THIS MAY TAKE FROM 2-4 WEEKS. AT THAT TIME WATERING SHOULD BE CUT BACK SLOWLY. THE AMOUNT OF WATERING NEEDED WILL DEPEND ON SITE AND WEATHER CONDITIONS. DAILY MONITORING/ADJUSTING FOR MOISTURE IS REQUIRED BEFORE THE SOD ROOTS IN.
